Job Description

Our growing organization seeks a Kelp Seed Production Coordinator to ensure supply of timely and high quality seed. Reporting to the Kelp Seed Production Manager, the Coordinator will support GreenWave's kelp domestication and propagation program which seeks to generate a reliable supply of early seed to ocean farmers to maximize the economic and environmental impact of their regenerative ocean farming activities. The Coordinator will support the stewardship of the gametophyte culture collection as well as the production of seed string, contributing to the long-term sustainable generation of kelp seed.

This is a full-time in-person position based at our headquarters in New Haven, CT.

Responsibilities

- Manage seed string nursery operations including:
 - Solicit orders for seed string and coordinate with farmers receiving seed
 - Sanitize and prepare facility for production
 - Perform daily nursery chores
 - Transport and filter seawater
- Support infrastructure team with farm and seasonal activities
- Assist in the management of the gametophyte collection
 - Prepare sorus for spore extractions
 - Establish new cultures
 - Perform media refreshments
 - Grind and upscale of cultures
 - Perform and document health assessments
 - Weigh cultures to measure growth
- Participate in data collection activities in seed lab and on-farm to track growth from gametophyte cultures to mature kelp blades in ocean

Perform weekly and monthly cleaning and assist in keeping the facility organized

Desired Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in biology or environmental sciences
- Familiarity with laboratory best practices and record keeping
- Experience working with G Suite
- Ability to work as a gracious and supportive team player
- Comfortable coordinating multiple deadlines and managing shifting priorities
- Willingness to be flexible and contribute to a wide range of duties

What we offer

- \$62,500-\$67,500 salary, commensurate with experience
